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Chokhamela - Poetic Expression of The Underpreveliged

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Chokhamela, a saint poet belongs to the Bhakti Sect (Varakari Sect) in Maharashtra. His correct year of birth is not available and there are different opinion about his place of birth. According to the scholar V. L. Bhawe, he was born at Mangalwedha near Pandharpur in Maharashtra and Dr. B. R. Ambedkar is of the opinion that he was born in the Vidharba region of Maharashtra.¹ It is believed that he died in 1338.

The word 'Varkari' means the performer of 'Vari' and the meaning of 'Vari' is frequent visits to a certain place. The Varkari frequently visits the holy place Pandharpur, at least twice in a year to have a glimpse of Lord Vitthal standing on a brick at the bank of river Bheema, commonly known as 'Chandrabhaga' in Solapur district of Maharashtra state.

The saint poets are the chief exponents of Varkari sect in Maharashtra during 12th to 15th century. Their devotional poetic creations are popularly known as 'Abhangas'. These poetic creations gave popularity and glory to the sect. the history of Marathi literature begins with the poetic creations of saint poets and plays vital role in the religious, spiritual, social and cultural life of Maharashtra. The Varkari sect believed to be established in the 12th century. The period between Saint Dnyaneshwar to Tukaram in the history of Varkari sect is supposed to be the golden age. Saint Dnyaneshwar is the founder of this sect, and it is spread by Saint Namdev and supported by Saint Eknath and it reached at its peak in the hands of Saint Tukaram.
