Perspective Plan 2017-18 to 2021-22

Criterion I: Curricular Aspects

- As our college is affiliated to S. R. T. M. U., Nanded, we have to teach the curriculum framed by S. R. T. M. U., Nanded. However, some of our faculty members participate in framing of syllabi as Board of Studies as well as members of syllabus framing committee of the University. The curriculum focuses on employability, entrepreneurship and skill development.

- Choice based credit system is implemented from the academic year 2018 –2019 for B. A., B. Com. & B. Sc. Programs.
- Value added courses imparting transferable and life skills are introduced.
- Field projects to students: Field projects shall be made compulsory for B. Com. Third year students.
- ➤ To strengthen the Feedback System: From academic year 2018 2019 the feedback from alumni and Employers will be taken and analyzed.

- To enhance the number of smart classrooms in the Academic Departments.
