# Report of Analysis and Action Taken

#### Report of Analysis -I

Feed Back committee in the college supplied feedback form To 70 students on random selection basis for collection of feedback from students on the infrastructural facilities / Non-teaching staff of the college. After collection and security of the forms, feedback committee only one student feels that.

- 1) Out of 70 students only one student feels that the non teaching staff is not friendly in behavior.
- 2) All the students have found satisfied with the library facilities, except two students, who have mentioned that the internet facility in the library is not sufficient.
- 3) Out of 70 students, only one student is not satisfied with the availability of books other that syllabus, in the college library.
- 4) Almost all the students have expended their satisfaction regarding laboratory facilities.
- 5) Out of 70 students, only two students have found not satisfied with the maintenance of cleanliness.
- 6) In case of clean and pure drinking water, out 0f 70 students, five students have expressed their dissatisfaction about the clean- pure drinking water.
- 7) Out of 70 students, ten students have marked the option indicating that the classrooms are not friendly for disable student
- 8) Out of 70 students, one student has mentioned that the supply of electricity in the college is not enough.
- Students were found satisfied with the activities of Redressal cell, career counseling cell of the college.

### Report of Analysis -II

The feedback committee supplied feedback form to students In the proportion of five forms per teacher to collect feedback on the process of teaching and evalution. The question incorporated was on the improvement of quality of the process of teaching and learning. The forms distributed for collection of feedback were as follows.

Science faculty: - 60 forms

Arts faculty: - 15 forms

Commerce faculty: - 15 forms

These 150 students were selected on the random basis and collected feedback in the month of Jan 2020 for collection of feedback for the Academic yea 2020-21.

The collected forms were scrutinized and analyzed by the feedback committee.

The committee has drawn following conclusions.

- 1) Out of 150 students, 137 students are of the opinion that the teacher completes his syllabus during the stipulated time.
- 2) Regarding regularity of engaging classes, 143 students have given positive response on the punctuality and regularity of teacher's engagement of classes.
- 3) Almost all the students were agreed that the teachers present themselves well prepared before the class.
- 4) Out of 150 students, more than 100 students have given the response that, there is no interaction in online mode of classes.
- 5) All the students were agreed with the statement that, the teachers have friendly attitude towards students.
- 6) Almost all the students responded positively with the teacher's use of ICT for teaching.

- 7) All the students were agreed with the timely continuous Internal Assessment.
- 8) All the students were agreed with the statement of transparent and impartial evaluation of students in continuous Internal Assessment.
- 9) Almost all the students were agreed with the affords taken by teachers for all round personality development of students.
